

## WEBSITE PRIVACY NOTICE

Your privacy is important to Valeas Capital Partners Management LP and its affiliates (“our”, “us”, “we” or “Valeas”). If we need to use your personal data for an unrelated purpose, we will notify you and explain the legal basis which allows us to do so.

Failure to provide personal data may mean that we cannot provide our services or products to you. In this case, we may have to cancel a product or service you have with us but we will notify you if this is the case at the time.

No automated decision-making, including profiling, is used when processing your personal data.

### **Disclosure and transfer of personal data**

### **Your rights**
